### 1.0 Policy Statement

Eckerd College considers its compliance with the various regulatory regulations a Aerosol cans are considered "Hazardous Waste" and are not to be disposed of in the regular waste. When you have an aerosol can that you wish to dispose of, please follow this procedure.

#### 2.0 Disposal Procedures

Any metal container that is sealed and contains a propellant must be discarded in an approved container. Containers have been placed in convenient locations throughout the campus. Common aerosol cans are: paint, cleaners, lubricants (ie; WD-40)

Disposal Locations: Each collection site will have approved properly labeled Hazardous Waste receptacles. These receptacles will be kept in the following locations:

- Facilities Management Office
- Ransom Art Pottery Building E
- All Dormitory Activity Rooms
- Student Affairs Office
- Franklin -Templeton Main Lobby
- Campus Safety Office
- Galbrith Marine Science Center Office
- Bininger Theater Office
- West Lodge Reception Center
- Other locations as the need arises

The receptacles will be collected semi-annually. If you find a receptacle missing or full, please contact Facilities at extension 8262.

If the aerosol can is damaged or leaking, over pack it in a container with a tight-fitting lid (i.e., 5-gallon pail or something similar). Label the outer container "Hazardous Waste – Aerosol can" and date the label. For removal of leaking aerosol can contact Facilities at extension 8262.
