

Spring Break Service Immokalee

Dates: Sunday, March 28th –Monday, April 5th

Cost: \$ 85 + \$2 offset = \$87 per person. This should cover the cost of your airfare, lodging, transportation, and food. **

What: We are going to Immokalee to be of service. We will be touring the tomato fields and learning about social issues (modern slavery in the agricultural industry). We will be volunteering with Habitat for Humanity, the Coalition of Immokalee Workers (CIW), and with the Immokalee Community Center. Our service will range from working with children, to building houses, to picking tomatoes alongside other Immokalee farm workers.

Immokalee is also located on the border of the Everglades and very close to the Florida Keys. We will have time to explore these sights and go snorkeling in nearby coral reefs.



Why: We are going to Immokalee to be of service and to learn about current social justice issues. Volunteers should plan to participate in all of the service activities. All other activities will help us learn about the environmental and cultural aspects of this Florida region. There will be opportunities to explore the community and the surrounding parks, but our primary goal is to be of service.
