

Spring Break Service Northern Ireland

Dates: Saturday, March 27th-
Monday, April 5th

Cost: \$626 per person. This should cover the cost of your airfare, lodging, transportation, and food.

Group size: 11 students + Brian

Lodging: Church floor or hostel

Transportation: We'll fly out of Orlando to Dublin. Once in Ireland, we'll get up to Belfast and around that city by bus.

What: We are going to N. Ireland to be of service. We'll have the opportunity to volunteer at the WAVE Trauma Centre (www.wavetraumacentre.org.uk). While the work hasn't been finalized, it may involve physical tasks.

We'll also face the challenge of living and serving in community.

Belfast is an interesting, diverse city. We'll have some time away from service work to enjoy the sights of this great city.

Why: We are going to Northern Ireland to be of service and to learn. Volunteers should plan to participate in all of the service activities. Other activities will help us to learn about the cultural distinctives and sometimes

troubled history of Northern Ireland. There will be plenty of opportunities to see some sights but our primary goal is to be of service.

I also must have a copy of your passport on this day or a copy of a receipt saying that you have applied for an expedited one.

What the \$626 does not cover: Passport and immunizations (these are required). Also, international ID card, baggage fees, free time funds, souvenirs, snacks between meals, &c are optional costs not covered by the \$626.
