Dates: March 27 - April 3

Cost: \$526 + \$4 carbon off set = \$530 per person. This should cover the cost of your airfare, lodging, transportation and food.

Group Size: 10 plus two leaders

Lodging: Hostels and bunk style shared rooms when in large cities. Three nights in host homes with limited electricity and no running water.

Transportation: Fly out of Miami to Managua then van transport for the entire week.

What: Volunteer work with the poorest of the poor in Managua and the small town of La Danta.

Environmental clean-up, teaching, exploring socioeconomic injustices that exist in Nicaragua. We will end the trip in Leon, a progressive city on the Pacific coast with a university and rich history.

La Danta is a small farming community on the Honduran border. We will be working with the children teaching sustainable farming practices and the importance of clean water.
