In Panama City we will work with the children living at San Jose de Malambo orphanage and help out on the orphanage farm. Work will include baby stimulation and playing with children in the HIV house. Some Spanish language helpful but not required.

We will work 6 days at the orphanage, yet make time to visit the famous Panama Canal and see the sights of cosmopolitan Panama City. The final weekend we will travel to the San Blas Islands off the east coast of Panama. The islands are home to Panama’s colorful indigenous Cuna Indians.
