Dates: Saturday, March 27th – Saturday, April 3rd

Cost: \$510 a person. This includes the cost of your airfare, lodging, transportation, food, and a fun day at the beach. Included is the required carbon-offset fee for this trip.

Group Size: 13 awesome students and your amazing leaders Alex and Tonya

Lodging: We will be staying at the Mission International mission house.

Transportation: We will fly out of Ft. Lauderdale to Trinidad. We will get around Trinidad via public transportation and transportation through the organization.

What: We will be traveling to a suburb of the capital Port of Spain called Diego Martin. We will be working with Missions International (<http://www.missions-international.com/>), an organization that provides social services to the population of Trinidad.

We arrive on Saturday to Port of Spain. We will spend our first day getting to know our surroundings. Monday through Friday will be spent working with Missions International. We will be assisting in a range of activities, including but not limited to, working in an orphanage, painting, mild maintenance, visiting nursing homes, and other

duties required to help with the upkeep of this organization.

The country's official language is English.
