# Camp Schedule

## Skills Camp

8:45      Report / check in  
9:00      Stretch / throw  
9:30      Fielding stations  
10:30     Hitting stations  
11:30     Lunch & Pool Break  
12:30     Infield / Outfield

The purpose of this camp is to teach the fundamentals of the game of softball. The three-hour morning schedule will include instruction before each skill is attempted. After the instruction of each skill, the campers will practice at various stations. Each day, the camper will practice both defensive and offensive skills. The session will end with a fun competition to see how well the campers have mastered or learned the daily skills.

## Pitching Camp

The purpose of the pitching camp is to teach the fundamentals of the windmill motion. This three-hour camp will include instruction in all aspects of pitching: snaps, delivery, follow through and developing different pitches. This session will end with a fun competition to see how well the campers have mastered or learned the daily skills.
